- Green Globe is a worldwide organisation that audits its members yearly according to internationally accepted sustainability criteria. - Together with our carbon administration partner Klappir, we are mapping out the complete carbon footprint of Hotel Café Royal, including scope 1,2 and 3 emissions. Closely monitoring our usage, data and CO₂e tracking the effects of our sustainability efforts in our CO₂e emissions.
- Lastly, we utilise a global platform for measuring and offsetting carbon emissions. Every time a guest books a stay with us, we automatically offset its carbon emissions by contributing to a selection of global initiatives that directly aid local communities whilst help increase renewable energy resources globally.
